Motion by Commissioner Tucker, seconded by Commissioner Lang to authorize the Human Resource Director to fill a Probation Officer vacancy. Motion carried.

The Building Committee provided an update on information being forwarded to the City of Austin in regard to the project costs of a proposed Justice Center. Discussion took place in regard to the site selected for the proposed Justice Center in response to questions from a member of the public.

The Solid Waste Committee provided an update on installation of equipment on the sorting line at the Recycling Center.
