

SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MOWER COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

October 14, 2008

The Mower County Board of Commissioners in and for the County of Mower, Minnesota, met in Special Session October 14, 2008 at 8:30 a.m. at the Courthouse in Austin, Minnesota.

Commissioner Hillier moved and Commissioner Lang seconded to authorize the Human Services Director to sign the Minnesota Food Support and Training Program Annual County Plan for federal fiscal year 2009, as prepared for cooperating counties by Rice County. Motion carried.

Commissioner Lang moved and Commissioner Tollefson seconded to approve local recertification for Zumbro Valley Mental Health Center to provide ARMHS in Mower County in 2009. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hillier moved and Commissioner Lang seconded to accept a \$60.00 donation from a law enforcement officer to be used specifically to benefit two children placed into foster care (case #19202315). Motion carried.

Commissioner Tucker arrived at 8:47 a.m.

Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Tollefson seconded to modify the 2009 County Budget portion of the Mower County Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP)/Children and Community Service Act (CCSA) Biennial Service Agreement by increasing the line item for emergency services by \$8,725 to a total of \$88,725, based on available funds in the state allocation. Motion carried.

Commissioner Hillier moved and Commissioner Lang seconded to temporarily reduce the eligibility requirements for Family Emergency Services between October 14 and December 31, 2008, or until the 2008 allocation is exhausted to in order to fully utilize the remaining funds to assist needy families. Motion carried.

Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Hillier seconded to renew membership in the Minnesota Social Service Association for 2009, and to designate the following persons as agency individual members:

Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Tollefson seconded to authorize the Chair and the Director to sign the following Purchase of Service Agreements:

- a. Sharon DeClue – approve amendment to contract for Home & Community Based Waiver Services, effective July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2009.
- b. Gerard Academy– renew contract for Residential Services, effective January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009.
- c. Mower County Seniors, Inc. – approve amendment to contract for Home & Community Based Waiver Services, effective October 1, 2008 to December 31, 2009.
- d. R&S Transport, Inc. – renew contract for Home & Community Based Waiver Services, effective July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2010.
- e. REM Woodvale, Inc. – approve amendment to contract for Home & Community Based Waiver Services, effective October 1, 2008 to December 31, 2009.
- f. Workforce Development, Inc. – renew contract for Food Stamp Employment & Training Services, effective October 1, 2008 to September 30, 2009.

Commissioner Hillier moved and Commissioner Lang seconded to approve the destruction of designated Agency files in accordance with DHS Rules and Regulations. All previously approved files have been destroyed. Motion carried.

SOCIAL SERVICE ACTIONS:

Commissioner Tucker moved and Commissioner Tollefson seconded to approve the Social Service Actions. Motion carried.

INCOME MAINTENANCE ACTIONS:

Commissioner Tollefson moved and Commissioner Lang seconded to approve the Income Maintenance Actions. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Tucker, seconded by Commissioner Lang to accept Omni Environmental's report and retain its services for plans and specifications at an approximate cost of \$5000- \$7500 for abatement of regulated materials for the Robbin's Block properties contingent on the purchase of the Robbins Furniture property. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Tucker, seconded by Commissioner Lang to enter into the Purchase Agreement for the Robbins Furniture property contingent upon the Seller

providing a clean, marketable title. Commissioner Tollefson nay, Commissioner Lang aye, Commissioner Tucker aye, Commissioner Hillier aye, Commissioner Cummings aye. Motion carried 4-1.

The County is looking at the possibility of providing a Medicare supplement plan for retirees which would be a benefit to both the retiree and to the county.

Commissioner Cummings left at 10:17 a.m. and returned at 10:19 a.m.

Motion made by Commissioner Tucker, seconded by Commissioner Lang to approve and authorize the County Coordinator to sign the Engagement Letter for Actuarial Services with Deloitte Consulting and adjust budget line items for the cost of the services. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Tucker, seconded by Commissioner Lang to approve final payment to Ulland Brothers, Inc. in the amount of \$124,241.07 for SAP 050-602-028. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Hillier, seconded by Commissioner Lang to approve Release of Letter of Credit (L5LS-576327) for Wal-Mart in regard to the 18th Avenue road improvements in Austin. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hillier, seconded by Commissioner Tucker to approve a lease agreement with Osmundson Brothers for six months at a rate of \$650.00 per month for property in Adams, Minnesota. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Tucker, seconded by Commissioner Hillier to approve the Light Detection and Ranging Technology (LiDAR) Contract with the State of Minnesota effective October 1, 2008 through September 31, 2010. Motion carried.
