

SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MOWER COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

June 8, 2010

The Mower County Board of Commissioners in and for the County of Mower, Minnesota, met in Special Session June 8, 2010 at 9:30 a.m. at the Courthouse in Austin, Minnesota.

Maryanne Law, Parenting Resource Center, requested the County Board to provide a letter of support / endorsement for the Minnesota Department of Human Services Regional Prevention Center Grant. No county funds are necessary as part of this request. Mower County is the host county of the fiscal agent for the next five years.

Motion made by Commissioner Hillier, seconded by Commissioner Ankeny to approve and authorize the chair to sign a letter of support for the Parenting Resource Center Regional Prevention Center Coordinator contract effective July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2015 with the MN-DHS Alcohol & Drug Abuse Division and support the Parenting Resource Center's administration of the MN-DHS—Alcohol & Drug Abuse Division project for the eleven county region. Motion carried.

Dustin Heckman, Mower County Historical Society, requested that Mower County appoint a commissioner to serve on a newly formed Historical Society Strategic Planning Committee to work as a liaison between the Society and the County. In addition a request was made for a county contribution (\$8,327.00 –11% of estimated project total) for a project to fix the roof on the GAR Hall in Grand Meadow and install energy efficient upgrades at the fairgrounds site.

Motion made by Commissioner Ankeny, seconded by Commissioner Gabrielson to refer the Historical Society's request for building project funds to the Finance Committee for review and recommendation. Motion carried.

The Chair appointed Commissioner Ankeny to the new Historical Society Strategic Planning Committee.

Commissioner Lang arrived.

Motion made by Commissioner Hillier, seconded by Commissioner Ankeny to approve the position of Jail Records Secretary with the job description to be equivalent to the current Office Support Assistant job description and authorize the Human Resource Director to fill the full-time position of Jail Records Secretary in the Sheriff's department according to union contract and personnel policies. Motion carried.

The Board recessed at 9:57 a.m. and reconvened at 10:10 a.m.

Motion made by Commissioner Gabrielson, seconded by Commissioner Ankeny to terminate the Medical Services Agreement for inmate medical services with Austin Medical Center pursuant to the agreement's provisions and approve an agreement for inmate medical services with Advanced Correctional Healthcare, Inc. effective upon the termination of the Austin Medical Center's agreement. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Ankeny, seconded by Commissioner Hillier to approve the Justice Center change order number 21 in the amount of \$10,411.50 with Joseph Co. to repair patch areas in the existing road (1st Street NE) adjacent to the building. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gabrielson, seconded by Commissioner Lang to approve change order (PR#32) to install built-in cabinets in the visiting judges' chambers that matches the other two chambers for a net change of \$2500. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Hillier, seconded by Commissioner Ankeny to amend the March 23, 2010 board motion to increase the offered contribution to the Austin Park and Recreation toward the cost of tree removal and tree replacement from \$5000 to an amount not to exceed \$10,000. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Hillier, seconded by Commissioner Lang to reject the proposal of Prairie Visions for a "Share the Road" project along County Road 56 to connect sections of the bike trail. Bicyclist safety on County Road 56 was the primary concern. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hillier, seconded by Commissioner Ankeny to approve final payment to Minnowa Construction in the amount of \$18,587.86 for SAP 050-613-009. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gabrielson, seconded by Commissioner Lang to set the project letting date to July 12, 2010 at 1:00 p.m. at the office of the County Highway Department and awarded at the County Board of Commissioner's meeting for County project to replace Bridge 50507 located on CSAH 25 in Udolpho Township and amend the 2010 Highway budget for the project to replace Bridge 50507 in the amount of \$300,000 from State Bridge Bond Funds. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Ankeny, seconded by Commissioner Hillier to enter into an agreement with The Main Street Project to develop the northwest section of Block 14

COMMISSIONERS' RECORD MOWER COUNTY, MINNESOTA

Original Village, City of Austin for a downtown plaza/park area with the following conditions:

1. County retains ownership of property;
2. The Main Street Project is responsible for all development costs;
3. The County and Austin Park & Rec shall jointly maintain the "Plaza" after development;
4. Any signage, including bench signage dedication, shall need the approval of the County;
5. The Plaza will be limited to an area in the NW corner with a dimension of approximately 65' north/south and 50' east/west; and
6. Any restrictions on use of the Plaza shall be determined by the County.

Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Hillier, seconded by Commissioner Lang to approve the Utility Easement agreement between Mower County and Austin Utilities for an easement on County property commonly known as the "old library lot" on 1st Street NW, Austin, MN. Motion carried.
