WHEREAS, Mower County is permitted by Minnesota Statute 203B.121 and 203B.23 to authorize a County Absentee Ballot Board effective July 15, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the county auditor office will establish a Regular, Mail and an Uniformed and Overseas Ballot Board for all future Primary and State General Elections; and

WHEREAS, the absentee ballot board must consist of a sufficient number of election judges, or deputy county auditor-treasurer's trained in the handling and counting of absentee ballots; and

WHEREAS, the County Board appoints the auditor-treasurer's staff and delegates to the Auditor the appointment of a sufficient number of partisan election judges as trained per Minnesota Statutes 204B.19 to 204B.22; and

WHEREAS, the ballot board(s) will meet daily, if needed, to process and record returned absentee ballots 45 days before each Primary and General Elections;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Mower County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes, until replaced, the Regular, Mail, and UOCAVA Absentee Ballot Board(s).

**RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, in order to preserve tax forfeited property and to insure against claims or injuries to the people that maintain, repair or view the premises, there is a need for the county to seize the abandoned personal property and dispose of it as authorized in Minnesota Statutes 504B.271.

**Proclamation #01-14**

**P R O C L A M A T I O N**

On motion of Commissioner Glynn, seconded by Commissioner Reinartz, the following Proclamation was unanimously passed and adopted by the Mower County Board of Commissioners at a meeting held July 15, 2014, at the Government Center, Austin, Minnesota.

**WHEREAS:** Unsafe speed was a contributing factor in 212 fatal crashes from 2011-2013 in Minnesota;

**WHEREAS:** These crashes resulted in 235 deaths; and

**WHEREAS:** Illegal or unsafe speed is a leading contributing factor in fatal crashes; and

**WHEREAS:** Illegal or unsafe speed was cited in 31 percent of all Minnesota alcohol-related fatal crashes in 2011-2013; and

**WHEREAS:** speed accounted for 24 percent of the factors cited in fatal crashed for drivers under age 30, compared to only 5 percent of the factors cited for drivers age 65 or older;

**WHEREAS:** 62 percent of speed-related fatal crashes occurred in rural areas with less than 5,000 population; and

**WHEREAS:** National Highway Traffic Safety Administration reports nearly 60 percent of all drivers report seeing speeding vehicles all or most of the time when they drive on residential streets as well as highways; and

**WHEREAS:** National Highway Traffic Safety Administration research shows motorists wrongly believe speeding is not a great risk to safety or as serious as other traffic violations; and

**WHEREAS:** Speeding increases potential for loss of vehicle control, increased crash severity leading to more numerous and severe injuries;

**WHEREAS:** The Mower County Safe Communities, Toward Zero Death Initiative and the Minnesota Department of Public Safety have a mission to keep all traveling citizens on Minnesota roads safe;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Tony Bennett, Chairman, Mower County Commissioners, in conjunction with Mower County Safe Communities Toward Zero Death Initiative and the Minnesota Department of Public Safety do hereby proclaim the month of July to be

**Speed Awareness Month**

in Mower County, MN, and urge all citizens to be diligent in obeying all traffic speed signs and laws.
