Additional Performance Credit Calculations and Supplemental Information

Describe below the progress made in meeting your program year work plan inspection goals. You must provide quantitative results for each compliance inspection and land application goal listed in your work plan.

*Sites that have potential to impact Upper Iowa and Upper Wasipi Watersheds, focusing on Manure App. (goal is 2 of 27): The upper Iowa/Wapsi watershed has 19 feedlots in it, its a limited geographic area in the county but a priority for the water plan. Five (5) feedlots in this watershed were inspected in 2019.

*Sites within a specified category 300-720 AU (*N&P Insp) (goal is 8 of 27): In my call for inspections this season, I sent N&P Record review requests to swine producers over 300AU in Adams and Marshall Townships. Additionally, I included the P-review on any other compliance inspection over 300AU (and some that were under, if they had the records for them!). In 2019, I completed 14 Desktop N&P reviews, all in Adams or Marshall Twp for this specific category.

*Leroy, Lodi, Adams, & Marshall Townships (goal is 9 of 27): All of the feedlots that I requested inspections for, whether Compliance or Desktop N&P were in Adams and Marshall Twp.

*Sites within Cedar River 1W1P (goal is 8 of 27): the western half of Mower County is moving into the Cedar/Wapsi 1W1P. There will be priority areas identified in that work plan which can be targetted in future Feedlot DAWP's. For 2019, the goal was broad - feedlots in the Cedar - within which there are about 240 sites. 41 Feedlots in the Cedar Watershed were inspected in 2019 (some of those were below the required-to-register threshold) 10 of them count toward this specific plan goal.
