

## RIGHT OF WAY FEES AND CHARGES

1. **Registration Fee - \$30.00:** This fee will be charged annually to each registrant to cover administrative costs associated with the review of forms, insurance, and bonds, and the cost of maintaining records of the submitted information. A registrant means any person who (1) has or seeks to have its equipment or facilities located in any right-of-way, or (2) in any way occupies or uses, or seeks to occupy or use, the right-of-way or place its facilities or equipment in the right-of-way.
2. **Hole Excavation Permit Fee - \$65.00:** This fee will be charged for each permit issued for the excavation of a hole. A hole is defined as an excavation in the pavement, or any other portion of the right-of-way, with the excavation having a length less than the width of the pavement.
3. **Emergency Hole Excavation Permit Fee - \$45.00:** This fee will be charged for each permit issued for the excavation of an emergency hole. An emergency means a condition that (1) poses danger to life or health, or of a significant loss of property; or (2) requires immediate repair or replacement of facilities in order to restore service to a customer. This work shall only be done by a registered permittee on a portion of their facility that has previously been reviewed and mapped by the County.
4. **Trench Excavation Permit Fee (0 to 1/8 Mile) - \$95.00:** This fee will be charged for each permit issued for the excavation of a trench up to 1/8 mile long. A trench is defined as an excavation in the pavement, or any other portion of the right-of-way, with the excavation having a length equal to or greater than the width of the pavement.
5. **Trench Excavation Permit Fee (1/8 to 1/2 Mile) - \$125.00:** This fee will be charged for each permit issued for the excavation of a trench up to 1/2 mile long. A trench is defined as an excavation in the pavement, or any other portion of the right-of-way, with the excavation having a length equal to or greater than the width of the pavement.
6. **Trench Excavation Permit Fee (1/2 to 1 Mile) - \$150.00:** This fee will be charged for each permit issued for the excavation of a trench up to 1 mile long. A trench is defined as an excavation in the pavement, or any other portion of the right-of-way, with the excavation having a length equal to or greater than the width of the pavement.
7. **Trench Excavation Permit Fee (Over 1 Mile):** Multiple permit fees as outlined above, in maximum increments of up to 1 mile, will be charged for trench excavations greater than 1 mile in length.
8. **Obstruction Permit Fee (0 to 1/8 Mile) - \$65.00:** This fee will be charged for each permit issued for the obstruction of the right-of-way up to a length of 1/8 mile. This permit will be required for, but not be limited to, such work as installing or maintaining overhead lines, maintaining utility poles or supports, and installing underground utilities in existing conduits.
9. **Obstruction Permit Fee (1/8 to 1/2 Mile) - \$95.00:** This fee will be charged for each permit issued for the obstruction of the right-of-way up to a length of 1/2 mile. This permit will be required for, but not be limited to, such work as installing or maintaining overhead lines, maintaining utility poles or supports, and installing underground utilities in existing conduits.
10. **Obstruction Permit Fee (1/2 to 1 Mile) - \$120.00:** This fee will be charged for each permit issued for the obstruction of the right-of-way up to a length of 1 mile. This permit will be required for, but not be limited to, such work as installing or maintaining overhead lines, maintaining utility poles or supports, and installing underground utilities in existing conduits.
11. **Obstruction Permit Fee (Over 1 Mile):** Multiple permit fees as outlined above, in maximum increments of up to 1 mile, will be charged for obstruction permits greater than 1 mile in length.
12. **Permit Extension Fee - \$25.00:** If permitted work is not completed by the assigned completion date, the permittee is required to notify the County prior to the assigned completion date and request a permit extension. An additional fee will be charged based on the additional time and work.
13. **User Fee:** The County reserves the right to establish a right-of-way user fee, but defers such fee at this time.
14. **Degradation Fee:** The County reserves the right to establish a right-of-way degradation fee, but defers such fee at this time.
15. **Delay Penalty:** The County reserves the right to establish delay penalties for permit work not completed by the assigned completion date(s), but defers such penalties at this time.
