MINUTES OF THE 5th MEETING OF
MOWER COUNTY BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

MEMBERS PRESENT: Kenneth Trom, William Schlichter

STAFF PRESENT: James Harberts

The fifth meeting of the Mower County Board of Adjustment was held on October 7, 1975 at 4:30 p.m. in the Mower County Court House. The first item of business was to elect a secretary to succeed David Benson who has left the staff. On a motion by William Schlichter and seconded by Mr. Trom, James Harberts was nominated to take Mr. Benson's place. The motion passed unanimously.

A petition from Mr. William Rabine, Dexter Township, was the next item of business. Mr. Rabine wishes to construct a storage shed within the 90 foot setback as required along Interstate 90. The board found that Mr. Rabin's property is completely separated from the rest of his neighbors because of a dead-end road which terminates at his farm. Thus the construction would not have any detrimental effects on adjoining property owners. The board also felt that because of topographic reasons, the proposed site was the best in the yard. A motion by Mr. Schlichter and seconded by Mr. Trom, that the petition for the variance be granted, passed unanimously.

Mr. Schlichter moved, and Mr. Trom seconded, that the minutes of the August 27, 1975 meeting be approved. The motion was passed.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 4:50 p.m.
