The regular meeting of the Mower County Board of Adjustment was called to order by Gary Braaten on Wednesday, June 26, 2002, at 2:45 p.m. at the Mower County Courthouse, Commissioners Room, 201 1st Ave NE, Austin, Minnesota.

Minutes of the May 29, 2002, meeting were approved as mailed on a motion by Mary Kenyon and seconded by Joan Roe. The motion passed unanimously.

Variance #459 – Missy & T.J. Bakken (Petitioner) and Evelyn Capelle (Owner) – A variance from Section 14-50(1) of the Mower County Zoning Ordinance to build an additional home per quarter section of land on property located at: E ½ SE ¼ & NW ¼ SE ¼, Section 2, Racine Township, Mower County, Minnesota. PIN #15-002-0030.

Reference was made to the site visit by the Board of Adjustment at approximately 1:40 p.m. The Staff Report was presented. Missy & T.J. Bakken discussed the proposal and explained they want to purchase a portion of the property and build a new home.

Statement from Public: Bruce Bucknell, representing Racine Township, spoke and stated they have no problem with the variance proposal.

After some discussion, a motion was made by Joan Roe and seconded by Mary Kenyon to approve Variance #459 with the following conditions based upon the testimony and the document from Melissa & Tyrel Bakken which will become part of the official record showing that the criteria for granting a variance has been met:

- 1. A zoning permit and ISTS permit must be issued for the new dwelling by December 31, 2005 or the variance is void.
- 2. No future subdivision of parcel without applying for and receiving a variance.
- 3. Home must be at least 1,000 feet from any licensed feedlot.

Bldg. Site in SW ¼ NW ¼ & W ½ SW 1/4, Section 1, Racine Township, Mower County, Minnesota. PIN #15-001-0040.

Reference was made to the site visit by the Board of Adjustment at approximately 1:55 p.m. The Staff Report was presented. Edward Doherty discussed the proposal and explained they want to move a mobil home on the property and construct a new home later. There is a well present on the property.

Statements from Public: Bruce Bucknell, representing Racine Township, spoke and stated they have no problem with the proposed variance.

After some discussion, a motion was made by Mike Adams and seconded by Mary Kenyon to approve Variance #460 with the following conditions based upon the testimony and the document from Duane & Patricia Doherty which will become part of the official record showing that the criteria for granting a variance has been met.

- 2. No future subdivision of parcel without applying for and receiving a variance.
