The 172nd regular meeting was called to order by the Chairman April 24, 1973 with the following members present:

Also present were Daryl Franklin, James Elza, Robert Shaw and John Beyer.

First order of business was consideration of Section Eighteen, Extraction of Earth Products, to be added to the Mower County Zoning Regulations. A motion by Stella Jensen seconded by M. E. Chesebrough that the Mower County Planning Commission recommend to the Mower County Board of Commissioners that Section Eighteen--Extraction of Earth Products be added to the Mower County Zoning Regulations carried unanimously.

Donald Bissen of Rose Creek appeared before the Planning Commission regarding notice of a complaint of violation of the Mower County Sanitation Ordinance and notice from the Sanitation Office to comply with the Ordinance within thirty days without having had a hearing at the Planning Commission. A motion by M. E. Chesebrough seconded by Richard Anderson that the complaint be accepted and a hearing on said complaint be scheduled for the next regular meeting carried unanimously. A brief discussion of similar situations throughout the County took place resulting in a motion by John Kramer seconded by Wm. Douty that the Sanitation Office be instructed to make a road side survey of the entire County, listing locations of all drain tiles discharging into the ditches. The motion carried.

A motion by Stella Jensen seconded by Richard Anderson that the Mower County Planning Commission recommend the following to the Mower County Board of Commissioners carried unanimously: That Section 7-B Regulations Applying to the Rural Zone of the Mower County Zoning Regulations be amended by adding:

5. Applications for special permits required for gravel pits, stone quarries, mines and other Earth Products are subject to the provisions of SECTION EIGHTEEN of this ordinance.

A letter from Rogers Lawn Service stating that the mobile home at his place of business is being used as an office. The method of handling applications for variances was approved. Minutes of the last regular meeting were accepted on a motion by Wm. Rugg seconded by Stella Jensen. A letter from Eric Hansen withdrawing his application for Subdivision Plat was accepted on a motion by M. E. Chesebrough seconded by Grace Dooley. The meeting adjourned.
