A special meeting was called to order by the chairman August 21, 1973 for the purpose of discussing the sanitary situation that exists at the Stardust Apartment complex. The following members were present:

Also present were Ross Graves, Mr. Jacobs and Mr. Elingsen, Robert Shaw, Wallace Sieh, Daryl Franklin, James Elza and Larry Landherr.

Mr. Landherr reported that the Sanitary system is operational and maintenance of the plant is recommended; construction of the plant is completed to the Sanitarian's specifications and he can sign off the project at this time. Surface drainage goes into the drainfield area and Mr. Jacobs claims the County road ditch flows water onto the motel lawn, causing excess water. The sanitarian recommended that water off the roofs be drained away from the drainfield. Mr. Jacobs also complained of the flies presumably from the compost piles at the Rogers Lawn Service. The complaint will be investigated.

The Building Regulations and new set-back regulations were discussed at length. The Winfield revised plat was submitted and referred to the Investigating Committee.

The meeting adjourned.
